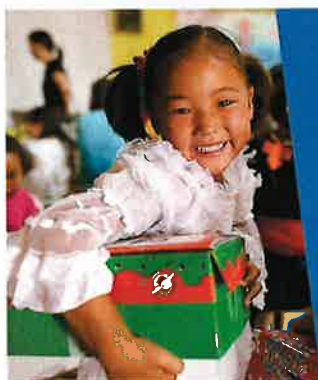

Current On-Site Worship Guidelines:

SUNDAYS:

- One service at 8:30 AM only
- No Sunday School or 2nd Service at this time
- We will worship in four separate places:
 - FLC 107 for Visionary and Young Adult Classes & their families. *(Simulcast in 107 & Levee)*
 - Levee for Ambassador Class and their families.
 - Sanctuary for Joy Class and families, visitors, and those without a Sunday School Class
 - Kidz Worship Area *(check in at basement entrance)*

Recommended Guidelines:

- We are encouraging families to sit together while maintaining a distance of 6 feet from other non-family members.
- One entrance and exit marked for each location.
- Greet each other with waves, not handshakes.
- Feel free to wear your favorite mask.
- Don't pass materials (bulletins will be laid on each chair).
- We all love to fellowship but try not to congregate in small areas where social distance can't be maintained.
- Communion will be taken at stations in each location.
- There will be offering boxes located at each worship area. You are also encouraged to use our online giving option or our texting service.
- Organized seating and dismissal.

- MID at Noon in FLC 107. *Use front entrance/exit.*
- Bible Study Online at 6:30 AND complimenting 242 Home Church Groups. *Call the office for more info.*

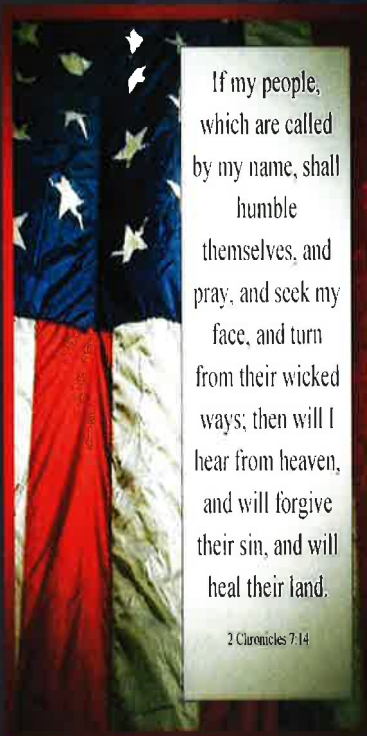

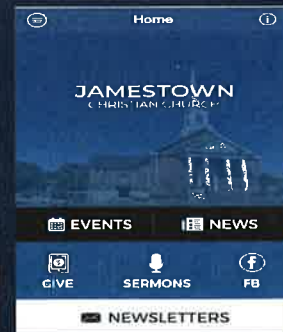
The Senior Ministry Activities at JCC will be in a holding pattern for a little while longer. We look forward to the time we can get together again!
